Instruction Manual for Plastic AAP and AJP* Series Spray Nozzles

Plastic nozzles are more breakable and far more fragile than metal nozzles. Please handle them with care and follow the instructions below.

*The standard AJP-PPS series has a different manual.


I. Installation Instructions

- 1. Be sure to flush the pipes before installing the nozzle to remove any dirt and foreign matter.
- 2. Apply sealant or sealing tape to the nozzle or pipe threads.
- 3. Pay attention to the spray direction when installing the nozzle.
- 4. First hand-tighten the nozzle, then lightly tighten it with an appropriate tool to adjust the spray direction. Be careful not to over-tighten.
- 5. Do not apply any shock or strong force to the nozzle.

Apply sealant or sealing tape to threads

II. Handling Instructions

- 1. Check the nozzle orifice regularly for clogging.
- 2. If the nozzle is clogged, remove it from the pipe and clean out the clog with a soft brush.
- 3. Do not attempt to clean the nozzle tip/orifice with nails, pins or other hard objects. This will damage the nozzle.



Note: Appearance and dimensions may differ depending on nozzle code.
